Results of Houselord's Own Maha and Antardasha



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In Vimshottari Dasha System, Dasha results are provided on the basis of relationship between Mahadasha and Antardasha lords. When one planet owns both, then no relationship can be formed between them. Therefore, the process of giving house specific results often creates confusion in the mind of students of astrology.

Through this article, I am describing the process to be following in such a scenario. Hence, this article focuses on the results to be given by houselord in its own dasha and andardasha.



Sage Parashar has clearly defined in Dashaphaladhyaya that planets give two types of results in their dasha:

- normal results, based on their planetary behaviour or natural significance, and
- special results, based on their lordship

Brihat Parashar, Laghu Parashari, Phaladeepika and others have mentioned below verse in this reference

न दिशेयुर्ग्रहाः सर्वे स्व-दशासु स्व-भुक्तिषु । शुभाऽशुभफलं नृणामात्मभावानुरूपतः ।।


It translates to that no planet gives selfspecific auspicious or inauspicious results during its own mahadasha and own antardasha.

This verse says that when a planet is the lord of both mahadasha as well as antardasha (e.g. Saturn/Saturn, Jupiter/ Jupiter etc.), then it does not give its house specific auspicious or inauspicious dasha results. Please note that we are talking about houselord specific dasha results. Various dashalords can be listed as below:

- If lord of mahadasha and antardasha is auspicious, then native will not get house specific auspicious results.
- If lord of mahadasha and antardasha is yogakaraka, then native will not get house specific yogakaraka results.
- If lord of mahadasha and antardasha is inauspicious, then native will not get house specific inauspicious results.

Let us take an example



In this horoscope, Saturn is auspicious as it is lord of ascendant house and 12th house. The prior mahadasha of Jupiter was very challenging for native as Jupiter is inauspicious as lord of 2nd and 11th houses. During Sat./Sat., native did not get any specific auspicious results but

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the environment and hope started building around him. Once Sat./Sat. got over, native progressed quite well, especially after 2002. Let us take another example:

21.11.1996, 12:50hrs., 07E36 49N12






In this horoscope, 5th/10th houselord Venus is yogakaraka. Venus/Venus dasha started from July-2016. Native has not seen any yogakaraka results but she has grown in confidence and started focusing more on her medical studies. Once Venus/Venus got over, she started seeing yogakaraka results and completed MBBS and got admitted in MD as well.

A question may arise that some antardashas are quite long, such as Venus/Venus, Rahu/Rahu, Jupiter/Jupiter, Saturn/Saturn, Mercury/Mercury etc., then will there be no auspicious or inauspicious results in such a long duration?

In such a scenario, the role of pratyantar dasha becomes predominant. Let us take an example in which the role of pratyantar dashalord is clearly visible:





Venus/Venus was in operation from May-2007 to September-2010. When Venus/ Venus started, native was studying Hotel Management and during the Dasha, he completed the course and got a job. Everything was running normal.

Then, pratyantar dasha of Saturn started in July-2009 for approximately six months. During this period, native suddenly got an opportunity to undergo a training abroad. The day, he was to leave the country, his father met with a car accident. Here, we see that Saturn as lord of pratyantar dasha played predominant role and gave results of maraka as soon as its dasha started.

Other options and exceptions

- Some Astrologers opine that the dashalord sometimes gives specific special results, but then it does not repeat such results in the entire remaining period of mahadasha. For example, if a child is born, then there will be no other child in the entire remaining period of mahadasha or if native is promoted, then there will be no other promotion in the entire remaining period of Mahadasha.
- We have also experienced that dashalord does not stop those events that usually happen only once like marriage, death etc. For example, India's former Prime Minister Mr. Atal Bihari Vajpayee died in Saturn/Saturn.

Are results cancelled or postponed:

One more question may arise here that if dashalord does not give its house specific results in aforesaid scenario, then would it mean that these results are cancelled and native would never get these results?

In this regard Brihat Parashar, Laghu Parashari and Phaladeepika say

आत्मसम्बन्धिनो ये च ये ये निजसधर्मिणः । तेषामन्तर्दशास्वेव दिशन्ति स्वदशाफलम् ।।

It translates to that they give these results either in related antardasha or in homogenous antardasha. Hence, we can say that these results are postpone.
